Grants – Health and Life Sciences

INTERNATIONAL ESSENTIAL TREMOR FOUNDATION (IETF)

Essential Tremor Research Grants

The IETF is requesting proposals for grants addressing the nosology, etiology, pathogenesis, treatment or other topics relevant to essential tremor.

Deadline: 28 February 2020

MERCK

Grant for Multiple Sclerosis Innovation GMSI

Grants are awarded to support promising translational research projects by academic researchers with the aim of advancing science and medical research for the ultimate benefit of patients with Multiple Sclerosis.

Deadline: 29 February 2020

WORLD ANTI-DOPING AGENCY (WADA)

Scientific Research Grants

WADA promotes and funds Scientific Research Grant Projects regarding development or optimization of analytical tools for the detection and/or quantification of doping substances or methods, consolidation of the Athlete Biological Passport; as well as the pharmacology of prohibited substances and drug cocktails. With this objective, WADA gives high priority to projects with direct and imminent applicability (including human studies if applicable) in the fight against doping in sport; and therefore, rarely funds basic research projects.

Deadline: 1 March 2020 (24:00 GMT)

PARTNERSHIP FOR CLEAN COMPETITION (PCC)

Research Grants Program

The emphasis is on original work that focuses on improving existing analytical methods for detecting certain drugs, developing new analytical methods to test for substances not currently detectable and discovering cost-effective approaches for testing widely abused substances across all levels of sport.

Deadline: Pre-Applications by 1 March 2020, 1 July 2020, and 1 November 2020

MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY ASSOCIATION (MDA)

Translational Research

This research is exclusively focused on funding the discovery and clinical application of treatments and cures for neuromuscular diseases (from proof-of-principle studies through phase 2 trials).

INTERNATIONAL OCD FOUNDATION

Breakthrough and Innovator Award

INTERNATIONAL OCD FOUNDATION

Young Investigator/Fellow Award

These awards support young investigators who are developing their careers while pursuing creative and impactful research projects on obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD) and related disorders across a range of disciplines.

FOUNDATION FOR PRADER-WILLI RESEARCH (FPWR)

FPWR Grant Program

FPWR is particularly interested in supporting projects that will lead to new treatments to alleviate the symptoms associated with Prader-Willi syndrome. Details about the funding priorities can be found in the guidelines.

CURES WITHIN REACH

Preclinical and Clinical Repurposing Research Projects

Cures Within Reach is launching two calls seeking preclinical and clinical repurposing research projects to address Meniere's disease.

THE BRAIN TUMOUR CHARITY

Expanding Theories Awards

This scheme supports pilot studies to explore/develop novel concepts that may eventually lead to significant improvements in clinical outcome for people with brain tumors. Proposals exploring innovative approaches that could fundamentally change the understanding, diagnosis, and/or management of brain tumors are welcome. Applications including a UK collaborator will be looked on favorably.

Deadline: 12 March (5:00 pm GMT), 3 September 2020 (5:00 pm BST)

ACTION ON HEARING LOSS

Discovery Research Grant

This grant supports projects that will generate knowledge to underpin the discovery and development of new treatments for hearing loss or tinnitus, or to improve the benefit gained from medical devices.

Deadline: Preliminary application by 12 March 2020

LUPUS RESEARCH ALLIANCE

Dr. William E. Paul Distinguished Innovator Award in Lupus and Autoimmunity

This grant is intended to attract exceptionally creative scientists from all relevant scientific disciplines and to provide them with robust and sustained support to explore ideas that could lead to ground-breaking discoveries in lupus research. Investigators working in areas outside of lupus are strongly encouraged to apply.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 16 March 2020 (5:00 pm ET)

AMERICAN EPILEPSY SOCIETY (AES)

Seed Grant Program

These small awards are designed to enable preliminary investigations that will lay the groundwork for subsequent substantial grants from government, industry, or other funding sources for research to advance the understanding, treatment, and prevention of epilepsy. At least one of the primary investigators (contact PI) must also be an epilepsy-focused academic investigator and an AES member. Preference will be given to applications for research to be conducted at U.S. institutions. Depending on available funds, applications may be considered from investigators outside the U.S. who otherwise meet the eligibility criteria.

Deadline: 23 March 2020

PROSTATE CANCER FOUNDATION (PCF)

Young Investigator Awards

Applications are especially encouraged from young investigators working on prostate cancer health disparities. Applicants may be working in basic, translational, computational or clinical research and need not be trained specifically in prostate cancer research to be highly competitive.

Faculty Grant Program

ALZHEIMER'S DRUG DISCOVERY FOUNDATION (ADDF)

Drug Development Program

The goal of this RFP is to develop therapeutics for Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. The focus is on building preclinical evidence in animal models and on advancing lead molecules to the clinical candidate selection stage.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 10 April, 10 July, 9 October 2020 (5:00 pm ET)

Prevention Beyond the Pipeline

Supports comparative effectiveness research, prevention clinical trials and epidemiological studies that probe whether the use/choice of drugs alters the risk for dementia or cognitive decline. Funding priorities: consortium of cohorts for Alzheimer's prevention action; comparative effectiveness research; cognitive decline and cognitive reserve.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 10 April, 10 July, 9 October 2020 (5:00 pm ET)

Neuroimaging and CSF Biomarker Development Program

This call supports the development of cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) and neuroimaging biomarkers for which there is a clear clinical need in Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. Novel biomarkers of neuroinflammation and synaptic integrity are considered high priority.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 10 April, 10 July, 9 October 2020 (5:00 pm ET)

Target Validation Pathfinder Grant

This scheme provides funds for small, translational research projects that show potential for an application to the Dementia Consortium or collaboration with the ARUK Drug Discovery Alliance.

Deadline: 15 April, 11 November 2020

CUREPSP - FOUNDATION FOR PSP/CBD AND RELATED BRAIN DISEASES

Venture Grants

CurePSP promotes research on PSP (Progressive Supranuclear Palsy) and CBD (CorticoBasal Degeneration) at preclinical and clinical levels. Particular interest will be on: i) molecular and cellular (pathological) mechanisms that may operate also in related diseases; (ii) translational clinical research involving PSP and CBD patients.

Deadline: 17 April 2020

VELUX STIFTUNG FOUNDATION

Grants

Grants will be awarded to basic or applied research projects in the areas of Daylight, Healthy Ageing or Ophthalmology.

Bronya J. Keats Collaboration Award

Proposals should focus on FA research that relies on international collaboration among investigators in at least two different countries. Special consideration will be given to proposals that bring new scientists to the FA community.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 15 May 2020

FRIEDREICH'S ATAXIA RESEARCH ALLIANCE (FARA)

Kyle Bryant Translational Research Award

FARA accepts Letters of Intent focusing on pre-clinical and clinical investigations that will advance treatments for FA.

Deadline: Letter of Intent by 15 May 2020

FANCONI ANEMIA RESEARCH FUND (FARF)

Research Grants

FARF seeks to fund interdisciplinary and translational research efforts that will lead to rapid discovery and development of therapies or strategies that treat, control or cure Fanconi anemia.

Deadline: Investigators are invited to submit Letter of Intents at any time. Full proposals will be by invite only.

BHD FOUNDATION (BIRT-HOGG-DUBÉ SYNDROME)

Research Grants

Successful research projects need to meet one or more of the following criteria: i) advanced understanding of the molecular and cellular biology of the Folliculin protein; the clinical manifestation/biology of BHD syndrome and/or the epidemiology of BHD syndrome; ii) maximizing the benefits of current research; iii) working towards technological innovation in therapeutics.

This grant aims to advance the science of treating Nemaline Myopathy, ultimately laying the groundwork for the development of commercially available treatments for these diseases.

Deadline: Send a summary of the concept targets prior to applying so that the grantor can provide early feedback about their current strategic direction.

JEFFREY MODELL FOUNDATION

Specific Defect Research Program

The program supports research to study the mechanisms and presentation of specific defects of the immune system, leading to a better understanding of the conditions and their impact on overall health outcomes.

Deadline: Applications are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis, so you may apply at any time.

ME RESEARCH UK (MERUK)

Research Grants

MERUK's priority is novel clinical and biomedical studies that help to unravel the biology of Myalgic Encephalomyelitis (ME)/Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (CFS), and studies that may point towards therapeutic strategies. Applications for pilot studies or seed-corn projects, including those which seek support for consumables rather than staff costs, are particularly welcome.
